



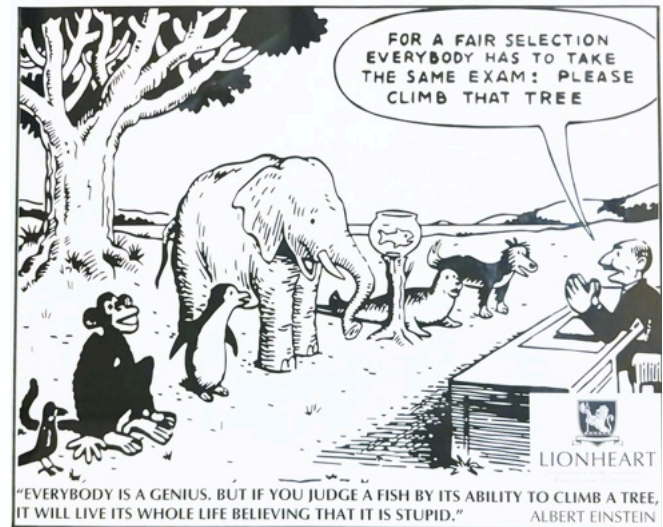

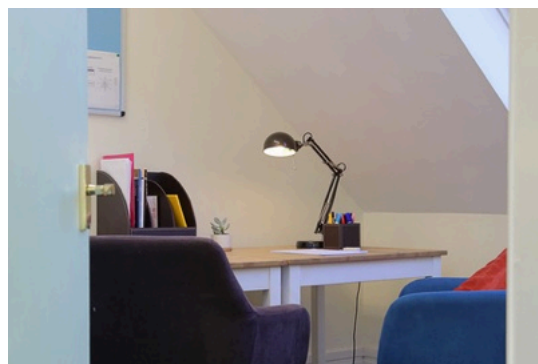
Our School

Located in Kensington, our school features 13 individual teaching rooms, each serving a student's personal classroom and study space. We encourage students to individualise their rooms, so they have a comfortable and welcoming learning environment. Communal areas exist for breakfast, lunch, and afternoon tea, complementing our fully-equipped science laboratory for practical learning.



Our Students

Given our size, admission is highly selective. We primarily cater to students in Key Stages 4 and 5, following GCSE or A-level programmes. Despite our small size, Lionheart offers a vibrant and supportive community where students share their unique journeys. Our bespoke educational approach enables significant academic and emotional growth, often exceeding what students have previously experienced.



Teaching Excellence

All teaching is delivered one-to-one by our tutors, each selected through a rigorous onboarding process. They possess at least an honours undergraduate degree and often hold postgraduate qualifications in their area of expertise, alongside extensive experience in tutoring and mentoring. We pride ourselves on our ability to adapt teaching methods to meet the individual needs of our students, moving away from traditional methods that may not have served them well in the past.

Our tutors' passion for teaching is complemented by their careers; we frequently have tutors from diverse professional backgrounds, including astrophysicists, surgeons, and international athletes! We offer an extensive range of subjects, from Mandarin to astrophysics, so that students are encouraged, often for the first time, to explore beyond the standard curriculum for the sheer enjoyment of learning.

As a JCQ and CAIE registered exam centre, we prepare students for any examination board, with the flexibility to sit exams in our communal space or study rooms.

Pastoral Care and Leadership

Our commitment to pastoral care is paramount. We integrate existing therapy and psychological support into our students' schedules, guided by professionals working as part of the student's team. Our Senior Leadership Team, all of whom hold postgraduate degrees in psychology and adolescent mental health, bring extensive experience in managing complex educational profiles. The Director of Education, a PGCE-qualified teacher with over 15 years of experience and psychotherapeutic training, ensures each student's programme is tailored to support their unique journey.



Schedule

Our school day begins with breakfast at 9:00 AM, followed by lessons starting at 9:30 AM. Lessons are approximately one hour long, with 10-minute breaks in between. Our lovely in-house chef also cooks our delicious lunches, taking on student requests when and where possible.

We offer the flexibility for students to complete homework on-site or at home, with dedicated private study periods available.

Fees

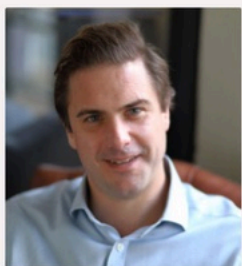
Our standard fees for the 2024-2025 academic year are £33,980 per term. Additional fees may apply for subjects requiring specialised expertise or facilities. Fees are payable in advance of each term, with examination fees and other expenses, such as trips and materials, billed separately. Our fees are currently exclusive of VAT, though this may change by summer 2025.

To secure a place, a 50% deposit of the term's fees is required, enabling us to effectively manage our waiting list.
